

Participant information, medical and registration form.

As with all adventurous activities giant slides do carry some risk to the participant. This risk is however usually many times smaller than perceived. Whilst all reasonable precautions have been taken to prevent injury to participants, risk cannot be completely eliminated. Participants must accept that there is a small element of risk and by completing this form they agree to accept this. Sunderland Live carries insurance as required by law however no cover is extended beyond that required. Participants are advised to consider personal accident cover.

During the giant slide you will be travelling along matting at high speed on a lilo and may bump into the sides or come off your lilo. Anyone taking part in the giant slide should be of reasonable health and fitness and have no existing illness, injury or medical condition which could be aggravated by them taking part in the activity. Video is available to watch at www.sunderlandlive.co.uk to give you some idea of what to expect on the day. Pictures can also be viewed on our website or Facebook page. Please talk to a member of Sunderland Live staff if you are unsure.

Sunderland Live reserves the right to refuse any person participating on the giant slide if they feel it is not safe for them to take part for any reason.

Participants must be at least 5 years old and all under 16s must be accompanied by a parent or guardian on the day. This person does not have to descend the giant slide. Participants of the longer slide must be aged 16 and over.

Participants must agree to follow all reasonable instructions given to them by the Sunderland Live events team; these instructions are for the safety of the participants and public.

Please make sure any loose objects are removed, shoes are securely fastened, long hair is tied back and tucked out of the way and any loose clothing is also tucked away. It is recommended that expensive items are not worn or carried on the giant slide. Any loss or breakages to items or property are the responsibility of the participant.

Fancy dress is permitted however anything which could interfere with the safe running of the giant slide such as capes and long wigs must be tucked away / fastened back. Please note it is not permitted to carry any loose objects including cameras on the giant slide for the safety of the public. If you are unsure please contact Sunderland Live.
